Stocktake is a one-day hands-on workshop that “takes stock” of your grazing resources to allow you to:

- Assess land condition & long-term carrying capacity using indicators of paddock condition
- Calculate short-term forage budgets
- Record & store monitoring data

The workshop will help you answer questions like:

- How healthy is my country?
- Do I have enough feed to last over the dry season?
- Why is it that no matter how wet or dry it is, some people always seem to grow more grass than others?
- We’ve had a really good year, and have more feed than we need for our own stock, how many extra agistment cattle could I put in the back paddock?
- If I feed a supplement, how will that affect the carrying capacity of the paddock?

Stocktake is FREE for eligible landholders under the FarmReady Scheme and VLMA Project participants – standard rate is \$330.00 per person. Please talk to Vicki to determine your eligibility.
